#### Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2018, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Implement “Read It Again – Foundation Q!” for Prep consistently with a focus on monitoring student performance aligned to the Literacy Continuum.
- Continue the roll out of explicit teaching of vocabulary via the “Strive” program to include Year 3 and 4.
- Develop a shared understanding of “Age Appropriate Pedagogy” and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively embed this practice in Prep and EAL/D.
- Implement programs and strategies that support EAL/D student’s progression of learning and improve their capacity to engage in classroom curriculum tasks by adopting Trauma Informed Practices.
- Develop a case management approach and tracking process, involving the school, region, parents/carers and the community, to support
  - “Out of Home” care and Indigenous students
  - Students who arrive late
  - Students with <85% attendance.
- Provide observation and feedback loops including “WOW” time to develop a culture of collaboration with continual improvement in the teaching of reading and writing.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum achievement standards by designing and supporting robust inter-school moderation processes.
- Provide professional learning to deepen teacher’s Professional Knowledge and Professional Practice on the teaching of reading and writing, the Australian Curriculum, Supporting EAL/D learners.
- Implementation of “Gift of Gallang” trial project to support the development of resilience with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders
