I wish you all very successful, rewarding futures.

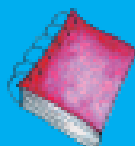
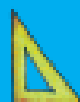
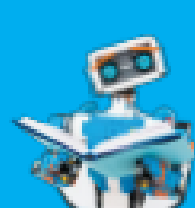
