Our school vision:

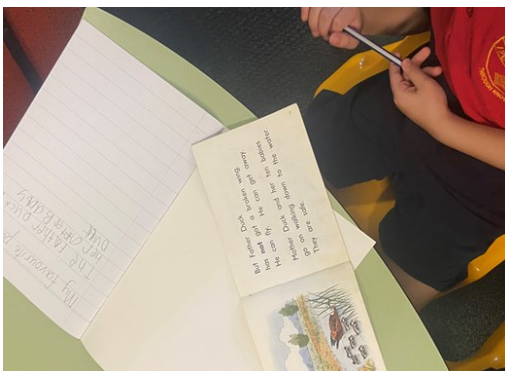
Engaged learners who have aspirations for a future filled with real choices, opportunities, equipped with skills for life-long learning.
